

Constitution of the Accounting and Finance Club of Elizabethtown College

Article I. Name

The name of the organization shall be the Accounting and Finance Club

Article II. Purpose

The purpose of the Accounting and Finance Club shall be to function as a social and educational extension of the members' academic studies. Its activities shall be designed to stimulate interest, scholarly attainment, and career development.

Article III. Membership

Membership in the chapter shall be on a voluntary basis and shall be open to all undergraduate students and faculty who are interested in its purpose and who desire to participate in its programs.

Article IV. Chapter Officers

The club shall elect a president, a vice president, a secretary, a treasurer and a public relations representative from among its regular members.

Article V. Duties of Accounting and Finance Club Officers

1. President/Vice President
 - a. The president and/or vice president shall preside at all regular meetings of the Accounting and Finance Club.
2. Secretary
 - a. The secretary will be responsible for informing all members of scheduled meetings and events.
 - b. The secretary will be responsible for assisting the president and vice president in administration decisions.
3. Treasurer
 - a. The treasurer will be responsible for the budget as allocated by the Student Senate, and any other additional funds.
4. Public relations representative
 - b. The public relations representative will be responsible for items concerning Club Council meetings.

Article VI. Faculty Advisor

The club shall be advised by a faculty member from the Accounting Department who is willing to serve in the position, and who is approved by club members.
