

## Constitution of Advocates for Peace

### Article I : Name

The name of the organization shall be Advocates for Peace of Elizabethtown College.

### Article II: Purpose

Advocates for Peace proudly upholds its name by expressing ideas and doing deeds in a peaceable manner. Non-violence and world preservation are goals striven for. The club's hope is to make the world a better place.

### Article III: Membership

Those members of the community of Elizabethtown College who wish to promote peace in the community through inner peace can join by attending a meeting.

### Article IV: Chapter Officers

1. The club shall have a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer from among its regular members. Each officer's term shall be his or her duration at Elizabethtown College.
2. The chapter shall nominate candidates for the officer positions during the spring semester.
3. Elections of the officers will be held in April and the new officers will assume their duties the following September.

### Article V: Duties of the Officers

1. The president shall organize and preside over all meetings of the club.
2. A secretary will be determined who will keep a record of all business conducted at meetings.
3. A vice-president will be determined who will notify all members of scheduled meetings and events.
4. A treasurer will be determined who will be responsible for the budget as allocated by the Student Senate and any additional funds.

### Article VI: The Faculty Advisor

1. The faculty advisor shall be a faculty member whose world view holds with the club's purpose.
2. The faculty advisor shall assist and advise the chapter and especially its officers in carrying out chapter programs and aid in developing new policies and programs.
3. The faculty advisor shall serve as the permanent custodian of chapter records.
