

Campus Gold Constitution

1996

Article I: Name

Section 1: This organization shall be known as Campus Gold.

Section 2: This organization shall serve as the collegiate affiliate of adult scouting.

Article II: Objectives

Section 1: To provide a college organization for adults scouts.

Section 2: To provide an opportunity for students to work with local scout troops.

Article III: Membership

Section 1: Membership to Campus Gold is open to anyone who is affiliated with Elizabethtown College and interested in scouting.

Article IV: Officers

Section 1: The officers of the organization shall be two Co-presidents, a Secretary, and a Treasurer.

Section 2: If the position of Co-president becomes vacant, the remaining Co-president shall assume the duties of that office for the remainder of the term of office. Vacancies in other offices will be filled by majority vote at a meeting called by a Co-president.

Article V: Duties of the Officers

Section 1: The Co-presidents shall:

- a. preside over all meetings of Campus Gold.
- b. contact neighborhood troops for campus events.

Section 2: The Secretary shall:

- a. notify members of meeting times and places.
- b. keep records of attendance and group membership.

Section 3: The treasurer shall:

- a. keep records of all financial activity.
- b. be Cookie manager.

Article VI: Election of Officers

Section 1: The officers shall be elected after nomination and majority vote.

Article VII: Meetings

Section 1: A meeting can be requested by any member, but is called by either Co-president.

Article VIII: Amendments

Section 1: Additions to and/or deletion of any parts of this constitution shall be executed by a two-third majority approval of the Campus Gold members attending.
