

Constitution Of The College Democrats
Of Elizabethtown College

Article I

Name: College Democrats of Elizabethtown College

Article II

Purpose: The purpose of the College Democrats is to advance and support the ideals and beliefs of the Democratic Party, to elect Democratic candidates to public office, and to educate the college community on political issues and concerns.

Article III

Membership Eligibility: All registered students at Elizabethtown College with an interest in the Democratic Party shall be eligible for membership in the College Democrats

Article IV

Officers: The College Democrats Shall have the following officers, with the following duties;

- 1 President- Charged with calling the meeting, preparing any necessary agendas, running the meetings, and coordinating any events sponsored by the College Democrats.
- 2 Vice President- Charged with seeing that the College Democrats as a club comply with any and all regulations set down by the Student Senate's Constitution or in any future legislation; and with assisting the president with his or her duties.
- 3 Treasurer- Charged with preparing a budget overseeing the budget and submitting a follow up budget to the Treasure of Senate each year.
- 4 Secretary- Charged with distributing pertinent information to the membership, preparing any necessary minutes of meetings, and overseeing all correspondences of and concerning the College Democrats.

Article V

Election of officers:

- 1 officers shall be elected to a one year term, beginning the first Tuesday in April.
- 2 Elections shall take place the last Tuesday in March.
- 3 All elections shall be won by a simple majority,
- 4 In the event that, when two candidates are running for an office, no single candidate receives a simple majority, a run off elections between the highest two vote gutters shall take place, with the office going to the candidate receiving the simple majority.

Article VI:

Amendment Procedures: Amendments shall be accepted to this constitution by the will of 2/3 of those attending a meeting which has been designated and made known to the membership as a meeting to consider proposed Constitutional Amendment.
