

Constitution And By-Law

Of the

Elizabethtown College Cricket Club

1.0. Name

The name of this confederation of cricket clubs shall be The Elizabethtown Cricket Club (ECC) (hereinafter referred to as "the Club").

2.0. Objectives

The purposes for which this organization is formed, the specific and primary purpose for which it is formed being set forth in Paragraph 2.1 below, are:

- 2.1** To promote, encourage, foster and develop interest in and understanding of the game of cricket throughout the Elizabethtown Community.
- 2.2** To encourage and develop youth cricket at college, regional and national levels.
- 2.3** To organize and promote matches and competitions at college, regional and national levels.
- 2.4** To maintain regular communication with all members on Club affairs.
- 2.5** To properly and fairly select and sponsor a representative college team.
- 2.6** To ensure that all cricket matches organized by and within the Club are conducted in accordance with the Laws of Cricket and that the traditions and spirit of the game are upheld by all Members.

3.0. Members

Eligibility to the ECC is open to all full-time undergraduate members of the Elizabethtown Community and does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, disability, status as a veteran, sexual orientation, or national or

ethnic origin. Majority membership consists of full-time/part-time undergraduate Etown students. The ECC is also open to faculty members and administrative staff.

3.1 Conduct

1. No member shall participate in the advantages of the Club or vote on any question until their fees (if any) and their subscription be paid according to the existing rules, and such payment shall be their distinct acknowledgement of, and acquiescence to the Rules and Regulations of the Club.
2. All subscriptions shall be paid in accordance with Section 4 of this constitution. The Board after having given the members 14 days notice of their intention to do so may erase their names from the list of members.
3. If the conduct of any member whilst on or near the Club premises or at any other cricket club be considered injurious to the character and interests of the Club and the College, the appropriate committee shall investigate such conduct. Complaints should either be in writing or by personal evidence. If the member is considered guilty, the committee is empowered to take appropriate action.
4. Any member ceasing to belong to the Club by, resignation, or otherwise shall thereupon cease to have any claim on the Club, unless so ruled by the Board.

4.0. Dues

- 4.1** Dues for College students, faculty and staff members are required to pay \$12.00 per semester or \$20.00 for the full academic year.
- 4.2** Non- college members are required to pay \$15.00 per semester or \$28.00 for the full academic year.
- 4.3** Dues will be collected on the first General Meeting of each semester.
- 4.4** Usage of the dues collected will be discussed on the day of the General Meeting.

5.0. Executive Committee of The Club

5.1 The Principal Officers of the Club shall be the President, the Vice-President, the Treasurer, the Public Relations Officer, the Secretary and a Faculty Advisor each of whom is required to be a Member of the Club.

5.1.1 The President shall be responsible for organizing and conducting meetings of officers and members, communicating with other colleges and cricket clubs, and the general supervision of the officers.

5.1.2 The Vice President shall be responsible for the communications within the Elizabethtown Community and outside. Ordering and keeping track of the inventory of equipment will be the job of both the president and the vice president, but no equipment shall be purchased without the knowledge of the other officers.

5.1.3 The Treasurer shall maintain the finances of the group and shall be responsible for communicating with Senate regarding group expenditures, and initiating fund raising events

5.1.4 The Public Relations Officer shall be responsible for reserving fields from the Athletic Department, reserving rooms for meetings and functions, communicating with the Office of College Relations, sending press releases, taking digital images and videos of matches, carrying out all publicity initiatives of the Club.

5.1.5 Secretary shall serve as the Club Representative for Club council meetings, and Senate meetings. They shall take minutes at all meetings and send those minutes to club members, keep attendance at practices and games, keep

information of all members, record all information of games and matches.

5.1.6 The Team Captain shall be responsible for activities of the ECC team, which will include communicating with, and organising matches both within the club and outside, and maintaining team spirit, and dedication of the members of the team.

5.1.7 Faculty Advisor/Coach shall serve as the liaison between the team and the administration and faculty of the college, ensure that the club operates within the scope of the college regulations and policies, coach and mentor the team,

5.2 The Officers of the Executive Committee shall be elected by majority vote at the first General Meeting in the Fall Semester

6.0 General Meetings

6.1 The primary General Meetings of the club will be held in the second week of each month whilst school is in session. Other General Meetings will be announced in advance by the Officers to discuss specific issues related to the Club.

6.2 Notification of the date, time and place of the meeting, and the business to be conducted, shall be e-mailed and posted in campus news

6.3 The Executive Committee shall be entitled to place on the agenda any issues related with the Club or the team that they desire.
