#### *Article I*

Sec. 1: Name: This organization will be known by the title:  
*Elizabethtown Art Club*

Sec. 2: Purpose: The Elizabethtown Art Club's purpose will be:

- b) to provide an opportunity for students to congregate and discuss different view points on art
- c) to organize field trips to art museums
