

E.P.I.C. Constitution

Article I -Name

The name of the club is EPIC, Each Person's Individual Culture.

Article II -Mission Statement and explanation of EPIC

"To provide students with the resources, opportunities, and peer support group to express and celebrate their individual culture."

EPIC will serve as a resource for students at Elizabethtown College. The club's central belief is that every individual possesses a very unique culture that is created and shaped by experiences and lifestyle. By collecting information on cultural activities open to students and by making this information readily available, EPIC will be useful facilitating students' expression and education.

Club members should be individuals that share the belief that a person's culture is comprised of more than his/her religion and family history, although these are important components of someone's culture. Members should feel that students should have the ability to express their individual culture in a welcoming and accepting community.

Article III -Roles of Officers

President: The President of the club is responsible for the planning of meetings and the delegation of the club's time and resources.

Vice President: The Vice-President should be capable to presiding over meetings and fulfilling all the duties held by the president in case of the President's absence.

Treasurer: The Treasurer shall be in charge of all of the club's financial matters and also be able to keep an accurate record of the club's financial situation.

Publicity Officer/Human Relations Officer: The Publicity Officer will organize the advertising of club activities. The Publicity Officer will also attend all Club Council meetings on behalf of EPIC.

Secretary: The Secretary shall be in charge of minutes for club meetings and also attend Club Council meetings if the Publicity Officer is unable.

Article IV –Elections

Elections will be held at the end of each spring semester. Terms for each officer will last for one academic year and reelection is allowed. If an officer is unable to fulfill a year's term, an election will be held at the end of the current semester to fill the vacancy.

Article V –Amending the Constitution

Any member can bring an amendment up for vote within the club. The amendment should be presented by the member and the voting will take place one week after the amendment has been presented. A unanimous vote is required for an amendment to be added to the Constitution.
