

Constitution- Greenpeace

Article I- Name

The name of this organization shall be Greenpeace.

Article II- Object

The object of Greenpeace shall be to further environmental education and advocacy on Elizabethtown College's campus.

Article III- Members

Any Elizabethtown College student will be eligible to join Greenpeace.

Article IV- Officers

Section 1. The officers of this club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Section 2. The officers shall perform duties as described in Article IV.

Section 3. The officers shall be elected by ballot at the last meeting of the Academic year to serve a term of one year and until their successors are elected. Their term of office shall begin upon adjournment of the meeting during which time they are elected.

Section 4. No person shall hold office if he is not a member and no member shall hold more than one office at a time.

Section 5. Duties of the officers

- a. President. The President shall set and preside over meetings. They will be a part of coordinating any campaigns and subsequent meetings held on campus.
- b. Vice President. The Vice president shall serve as assistant to the President and shall serve as an interim officer if vacant from the meeting.
- c. Secretary. The Secretary shall serve as custodian of all records of Greenpeace. The Secretary shall record all discussions and business performed during meetings of the club and shall report the minutes to the club at the following meeting.
- d. Treasurer. The Treasurer shall maintain accurate records of all financial concerns of the club. The treasurer shall be given the right to access funds and accounts through the Elizabethtown College Business Office and shall allot monies as mandated by the membership of Greenpeace.

Article V- Meetings

Section 1. A regular meeting of Greenpeace shall occur every other week.

Section 2. A special meeting shall be held if deemed necessary.

Section 3. Members shall be reminded by the secretary 1 day before each meeting.

Section 4. Four members shall constitute a quorum.

Article VI- Parliamentary Authority

The President will preside over meeting, or another officer in their absence, and determine how the meeting shall run.

Article VII- Amendment

Section 1. This constitute may be amended at any regular or special meeting by a simple majority of the members present, provided that notice of the amendment was given to the members at least 1 day in advance.

Section 2. Upon ratification, amendments shall be sent to the Student Senate Judicial Committee and shall be put into effect upon approval from the committee.
