Article I

Name: Hillel

Article II

Purpose: The purpose of Hillel shall be:

1. To help create a sense of community among the Jewish students of Elizabethtown College, and help them with their sense of their own Jewish identity.
2. To have monthly meetings in which religious concerns and topics can be discussed.
3. To coordinate events for the Elizabethtown College community to help them Better understand the Jewish religion and its traditions.

Article III

Any college student may enroll provided that at least one parent is Jewish.

Article V

Officers:

- a. President—Conducts meeting, makes sure officers fulfill requirements. If Requirements are not meant, it is his/her responsibility to take action.
- b. Vice-President—Conducts meetings, shares and supports President's duties.
- c. Treasurer—Is responsible for budget and accounts
- d. Secretary—Records and communicates the club's activities.
- e. Representative—Plan and organize activities and calendar.

Article VI

Bylaws:

1. Officers are elected by a majority vote in April of the Spring term.
2. Terms shall last at least one full academic year or two semesters.
3. Officers are expected to attend all meetings unless previous notification was given.
4. Two unexcused absences from meetings per semester will result in loss of the position.
