

Constitution

Article I

Name

The name of this club shall be the Martial Arts Club

Article II

Purpose

1. To give the Elizabethtown College students, staff, and faculty a better understanding of the Martial Arts.
2. To teach various styles of Martial Arts to the Elizabethtown College Campus.

Article III

Mission

The mission of the Elizabethtown Martial Arts Club is to teach and promote: discipline, self-defense and safety, physical fitness, character development, open-mindedness, peace and serenity not only to our members but for our club to act as an example to the surrounding community.

Article IV

Membership

1. Any member of the Elizabethtown College's students, staff, and faculty are eligible for membership.
2. We also welcome outside individuals with Martial Arts experience to broaden our own understanding of the Martial Arts.
3. Club members do not pay an annual fee, however, they may be required to provide funds for their own equipment.

Article V

Officers

1. The club officers shall be President and Treasurer and will be elected from the student body.

2. All members of the Martial Arts Club are considered equal Representatives of the club.
3. All offices are voluntary and are made official with the consent of members present at the meeting where the office change takes place.
4. Officers may hold their position as long as they remain a part of the student body, however, they may be asked to stop down by other members of the club at any time.

Article VI

Duties of the Officers

1. The President, Treasurer, and Club Representatives share club responsibilities, however, the President and Treasurer will be in charge of club meetings (not including class times).
2. The President implements club activities outside of classes, as well as acts as the primary representative to the Elizabethtown College community.
3. The Treasurer shall be involved in all money matters for the Martial Arts Club, including the budget as well as transactions through the Business Office.
4. Should the President be unable to perform his or her duties the responsibility will fall 1st to the Treasurer, 2nd to a member of the Executive Board and finally to a Club Representative.
5. If the Treasurer is unable to perform his or her duties the responsibility will fall 1st to the President, 2nd to a member of the Executive Board and finally to a Club Representative.

Article VII

Executive Board

1. The Executive Board shall approve all actions and activities necessary and proper for the functioning of the Martial Arts club.
2. The Executive Board shall consist of all club instructors and officers.

Article VIII

Amendments

Amendments to the Martial Arts Club Constitution will be proposed, voted on, and implemented in a timely fashion by a majority vote of all present club members.
