

Constitution

Article I – Name

The name of the organization is Outdoors Club

Article II – Purpose

The purpose of the Outdoors Club is to promote the engagement in outdoor activities and encourage the congregating of people with similar outdoors recreational interests.

Article III – Membership

Section 1 – Eligibility

The organization is open to all students of the Elizabethtown College community who express an interest in the outdoors.

Section 2 – Membership Process

Membership is open to all students year round.

Section 3 – Dues

Members must pay a due of \$5.00 a year.

Article IV – Meetings

Meetings will be held every two weeks.

Article V – Officers and Duties of Officers

Section 1 – Officers

Election will be held in April of every year for new officers. All present members are eligible for officer positions. The Outdoors Club will have the following officers:

President, Vice-president, Secretary, Treasurer, and Club Council Representative. The term of office is for two semesters. A nomination and then election will fill any vacancy in an office.

## Section 2 – Duties

President: The president will be responsible for running and planning the meetings.

He/she will also be in charge of contacting people about and planning activities. Finally he/she will instruct in other officer responsibilities.

Vice-president: The vice-president will be responsible for assisting the president in all duties and running the meeting if the president is unable to attend.

Treasurer: The treasurer will be responsible for handling the finances of the club, researching and organizing fund-raisers, and also making sure dues are paid.

Secretary: The secretary will be responsible for taking minutes at all meetings. He/she will be expected to update members on what occurred at a meeting if they were unable to attend. The secretary will also be responsible for e mailing and informing members about meetings.

Club Council Representative: The Club Council Representative will be responsible for attending all Club Council meetings and report on them to the Outdoors Club.

## Article VI – Amendments

This constitution can be amended at a meeting by a three-fourths majority vote of members. This constitution will be reviewed and evaluated every two years.

## Article VII – Advisors

There will be one faculty advisor.
