ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the organization shall be the Elizabethtown College Photography Club.

ARTICLE II MISSION

The Elizabethtown College Photography Club shall provide students a venue to explore interests in photography and its creative process. The club shall also network students who share common interests in photography.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- A. All full-time students enrolled in Elizabethtown College with a general interest in photography, shall be eligible to be a member of the club.
- B. A student may become a member of the Photography Club at any point during the academic year.

ARTICLE IV ELECTIONS

The Photography Club's officers shall be elected from within, and by, Photography Club members. Elections shall take place annually in the month of April. Any member of the Photography Club is eligible to run for any officer position.

ARTICLE V OFFICER DUTIES

- A. President
  - 1. The President shall call and preside over all monthly meetings of the Photography Club.
  - 2. The President shall oversee all activities planned by the Photography Club.
  - 3. The President shall guide the other officers in the fulfillment of their duties, and act as a liaison between club advisor and club members.
- B. Vice President
  - 1. The Vice President shall preside over meetings of the Photography Club in the absence of the President.
  - 2. The Vice President shall aid the President in all duties.
  - 3. The Vice President shall be responsible for the logistics and planning of all club activities, including fundraisers.
- C. Secretary
  - 1. The Secretary shall be responsible for the recording and distributing the minutes after each meeting of the Photography Club.
  - 2. The Secretary shall be responsible for notifying club members, via e-mail, about future club meetings.
  - 3. The Secretary shall also act as Photography Club's representative during monthly Club Council meetings.
- D. Treasurer

1. The Treasurer shall be responsible for handling finances of the Photography Club, including membership fees.
2. The Treasurer shall attend the annual Treasurer's Seminar on behalf of the Photography Club.
3. The Treasurer shall keep and report records of the Photography Club's financial standings.

#### ARTICLE VI CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT PROCEDURES

For an amendment to the Photography Club's constitution to pass, a two-thirds (2/3) affirmative vote of the membership is required.

#### ARTICLE VII ADVISOR

There will be one advisor of the Photography Club. This advisor may be a faculty or staff member at the College. Current Photography Club advisor is Dr. Hans-Erik Wennberg of the Communications Department.
