

Elizabethtown College Poker Club

Constitution & Membership

Established 2005

Article I

Name

The name of this student organization shall be the Elizabethtown College Poker Club, referred to hereinafter as ECPC.

Article II

Mission Statement

The mission of the ECPC is to provide a quality poker experience for the student population of Elizabethtown College, while educating students on the need to maintain healthy levels of play at all times.

Article III

Purpose

- SECTION 1 The purpose of the ECPC is to provide a fun, free, and safe environment for students to learn and play the many variations of the card game known as poker.
- SECTION 2 Additionally, the ECPC is intended to educate students on issues pertaining to playing poker, such as any addiction- or gambling-related matters.

Article IV

Membership & Eligibility

- SECTION 1 The ECPC shall be referred to, for Student Senate purposes, as a Type A (Inclusive) club.
- SECTION 2 All officers of the ECPC shall be members of the Elizabethtown College student body.
- SECTION 3 All members of the College community are eligible and welcome to participate in any ECPC-sanctioned event.
- SECTION 4 No student, faculty, or staff member will be turned away from membership in the ECPC on the basis of race, religion, national origin, handicap, sexual orientation, or veteran status.
- SECTION 5 All Elizabethtown College community members, in order to become recognized members of the ECPC, must be approved for membership by at least 50% plus one of the previously recognized members of the club.
- SECTION 6 All recognized members of the ECPC must pay a semesterly due of \$2. These dues are to be used as a base for a club budget.
- SECTION 7 The majority of ECPC membership must come from current Elizabethtown College students.

Article V

Officers

SECTION 1 Officers of the ECPC will be referred to as President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Officers of the organization will hold office for one academic year, unless removed from office by a 2/3 majority vote of club membership.

SECTION 2 The duties of said officers are as follows:

President: Help organize and coordinate events, oversee ECPC meetings

Vice President: Work in conjunction with the president, represent ECPC at Club Council

Secretary: Record all minutes from meetings, maintain club schedule

Treasurer: Manage all budget items

Article VI

Amendments

SECTION 1 In order to amend the ECPC Constitution, a recognized member of the ECPC must submit, in writing, their proposed change to the Constitution during a regularly-scheduled ECPC meeting.

SECTION 2 In order for the amendment to be approved, a vote must be taken; 50% plus one recognized members must approve the proposed amendment.

SECTION 3 All approved amendments must be submitted to the Elizabethtown College Student Senate Judicial Committee for final approval.

Article VII

Faculty/Staff Advisor

SECTION 1 The Faculty/Staff advisor will oversee all club activities.

SECTION 2 It is expected that the advisor will work with the club officers to create the ideal poker experience for members of the ECPC.

SECTION 3 It is also anticipated that the advisor will with the club president on a regular basis to discuss any pertinent ECPC issues or plans.
