

Elizabethtown College Political Science Club

Constitution

Article I

- Section 1 : The Political Science Club is dedicated to the furtherance of knowledge about and participation in politics and government on the local, state, federal and international levels.
- Section 2 : Membership in the Political Science Club is open to all Elizabethtown College students regardless of race, gender or ethnic background
- Section 3: The Political Science Club is a non-partisan entity, and will at no time discriminate against any member on the basis of their political views.

Article II

- Section 1 : The Executive Cabinet of the Political Science Club consists of a President, a Vice-President, a Treasurer, and a Secretary.
- Subsection A : The President will be responsible for calling to order of all meetings and for the conduction or delegation of all club business.
- Subsection B : The Vice-President will be acting President and carry all aforementioned responsibilities as per the request or absence of the President.
- Subsection C : The Treasurer will be responsible for the maintenance of the club's funds and budget.
- Subsection D: The Secretary will be responsible for the maintenance of the club's member rolls as well as keeping the minutes of all club meetings.
- Section 2 : The Executive Cabinet shall be elected by simple majority once nominations and seconds have been secured.
- Section 3 : Elections are to be held during the last week of March with the Executive Cabinet-elect taking office during the second week of April every year.

Article III

- Section 1 : Club meetings are to take place at least once a month during the academic year with notice to be given to all members at least 24 hours in advance via phone or campus mail.
- Section 2 : All members of the Executive Cabinet are expected to attend all meetings unless otherwise noted.

Section 3:

While the Executive Cabinet is to have control of all meetings unless otherwise delegated, the ultimate control over the Political Science Club is vested in the club's faculty advisor.
