

Constitution of the Pre-Law Club
Of Elizabethtown College

Article I: Name

Pre-Law Club of Elizabethtown College

Article II: Purpose

The purpose of the Pre-Law Club shall be to educate and inform pre-law students about the law school experience and the legal profession.

Article III: Membership Eligibility

All registered students at Elizabethtown College with an interest in law school shall be eligible for membership in the Pre-Law Club.

Article IV: Officers

The Pre-Law Club shall have the following officers with the following duties:

1. President – charged with calling meetings, preparing any necessary agendas, running the meetings, and coordinating any events sponsored by the Pre-Law Club.
2. Vice-President – charged with ensuring that the Pre-Law Club complies with any rules or regulations set down by the Student Senate, whether in the Student Senate's Constitution or in any future legislation, and with assisting the President in his/her duties.
3. Treasurer – charged with preparing a budget, overseeing that budget, and submitting a follow-up budget to the Treasurer of Student Senate at the end of the year.
4. Secretary – charged with distributing pertinent information to the members, preparing any necessary minutes of meetings, and overseeing all correspondence of and concerning the Pre-Law Club.
5. Club Council Representative – charged with attending Club Council meetings, reporting the activities of the Pre-Law Club to Club Council, and reporting to the Pre-Law Club the activities and discussions of the Club Council.

Article V: Election of Officers

1. Officers shall be elected to a one-year term.
2. Elections shall take place during the Spring Semester.
3. All elections shall be won by a simple majority.

Article VI: Amendment Procedure

Amendments shall be accepted to this Constitution by the will of 2/3 of those attending a meeting which has been designated and made known to the membership as a meeting to consider a proposed constitutional amendment.
