Constitution

Article I- Name

The Name of this club will be the Sociology/Anthropology Criminal Justice Club;
Also known as, S/A C. J. club.

Article II- Mission Statement

Providing all students of Elizabethtown College with the opportunity to explore disciplines such as Sociology, Anthropology, Criminology and Archaeology. These disciplines deal with a variety of social, biological and cultural environments that require researching the past present and looking into the future.

Article III- Members

The S/A C. J. club is an inclusive club, welcome to all Elizabethtown College Students.

Article IV- Officers

Section 1. The officers of this club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer

Section 2. The officers shall perform the duties as described in Article VI.

Section 3. The officers shall be elected by ballot at the last meeting of the academic year to serve a term of one year and until their successors are elected. Their term of office shall begin upon adjournment of the meeting during which time they are elected.

Section 4. No person shall hold office if he is not a member, and no member shall hold more than one office at a time.

Section 5. Duties of the Officers

President: The president will head all club meetings and present new ideas to the members of this club. He/ she will also report to the faculty advisor about anything the club has talked about.

Vice President: The vice president will help the president in any official decisions, further, is responsible for the secretary, treasurer, and club council representative. The vice president will also be in charge of the club meetings when the president is unable to attend.

Secretary: The secretary is in charge of taking notes on all club meetings and distributing them to club members via email.

Treasurer: The treasurer will be responsible for the budget for the club. He/she will report the amount of money, and other financial responsibilities of the club, at the beginning of each meeting. He/ she will also be responsible for trip approvals, and any other financial obligations of the club.

Article V- Meetings

Section 1. A regular meeting of the group shall occur every week.

Section 2. A special meeting shall be held upon the decision of the president.

Section 3. $\frac{3}{4}$ of Officers shall constitute quorum. Attendance is recommended, but not required.

Article VI- Amendments to the Constitution

Section 1. This constitution may be amended at any regular or special meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present, provided that notice of the amendment was given to the members at least 2 days in advance.

Section 2. Upon ratification, amendments shall be sent to the Student Senate Judicial Committee and shall be put into effect upon approval from the Committee.
