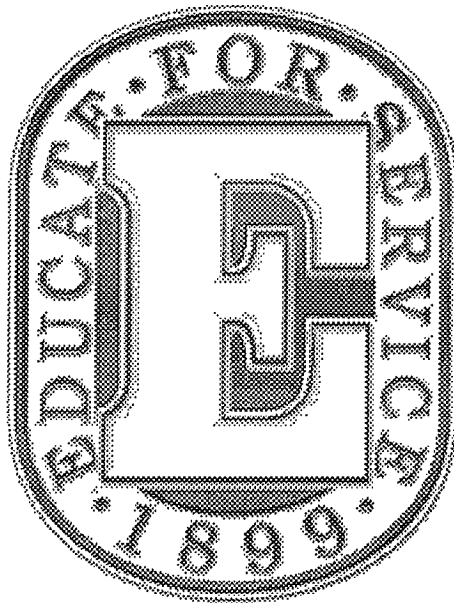

SOHIS Etown Constitution

Article I. Name and Purpose.

Section I. This organization shall be known as La sociedad hispanica de la Universidad de Elizabethtown (SOHIS Etown).

Section II. The purpose of SOHIS Etown is to provide resources on Spain and Latin America and to sponsor educational and social events related to the languages and cultures of these countries for all interested students of Elizabethtown College.

Article II. Membership.

Section I. Membership is open to any Elizabethtown College students regardless of race, color, gender, ethnic origin, sexual orientation, or religion who are interested in learning about Spain and Latin America and their cultures.

Section II. Qualifications for members include only an interest in the purposes of SOHIS Etown and attending the club meetings. A knowledge of Spanish is not mandatory, but is encouraged. Membership will be established and recorded during the first club-wide annual meeting.

Article III. Officers and Duties.

Section I. The officers of SOHIS Etown are President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and Club Council Representative. These positions may not be held by the same person.

Section II. The duties of each office are as follows:

President: The President will conduct all meetings and maintain order at club meetings. In addition, the President will be in charge of organizing events and acting as liaison to other clubs on campus.

Vice President: The Vice President will take over duties when the President is unable to perform said duties as well as act as a contact for information about study abroad opportunities and attend treasurer meetings.

Treasurer: The Treasurer will be in charge of all financial business including the record keeping, as well as fundraising ideas and financial monetary request forms.

Secretary: The Secretary will write the records of the meetings, send e-mails regarding upcoming events, and be responsible for publicity.

Club Council Representative: The Club Council Representative will attend all Club Council meetings and report back to the officers on club matters. This position will be appointed, preferably to a freshman, during the first club-wide meeting of the academic year.

Article IV. Finances.

Section I. Money will be allocated from Student Senate and club fundraisers.

Article V. Amending Constitutions and Bylaws.

Section I. Should a member feels dissatisfied with the current constitution; he or she may bring it to the attention of the officers at the next meeting for discussion.

Article VI. Meetings.

Section I. SOHIS Etown shall decide on a bi-weekly meeting time each semester.

Section II. The general format of the meeting will be informal discussions of club activities and events.
