

S.M.I.L.L.E. CONSTITUTION
(Students Making Individual Lives Enriched)

Article 1: Purpose

- 1.) The purpose of this club shall be as follows:
 - a.) To provide an opportunity for all students interested in interacting and sharing their knowledge, questions, ideas, and feelings with those in need of such relationships.
 - b.) To provide an opportunity for residents of nursing homes, hospitals, children's homes, private homes, etc. to interact in a positive manner thereby enriching the lives of college students.
 - c.) To sponsor a variety of activities for club members each semester.

Article 2: Requirements for Membership

- 1.) Membership is open to any college student interested in and dedicated to contributing their time and energy to enriching the lives of others.
- 2.) The members must be willing to meet bi-weekly for general meetings and the planning of activities.

Article 3: Leadership

- 1.) There shall be an Executive Board consisting of a president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer. Their powers and duties are as follows:
 - a.) President: Reside over all meetings and maintain fluidity in function. Supervise the creation and execution of all club activities.
 - b.) Vice-President: Reside over all meetings and maintain fluidity in function. Assume the duties of the president, when absent or as needed.
 - c.) Secretary: Keep accurate minutes of each meeting, and give reports of the minutes from previous meetings. Record the attendance of all club members for each meeting and activity.
 - d.) Treasurer: Manage the funds and accounts of the club, and provide accurate records of all transactions.

**All board members are responsible for coordinating and organizing, at least, one activity per semester.

- 2.) The term of office is open to any active member of the club for two semesters following the election.
 - a.) Elections will be held at the end of each fall semester, and elected board members will begin their term in the spring semester.
- 3.) A 3/5 majority vote is required for election.

a.) Executive board members are excluded from voting.

4.) Any Executive Board member who fails to meet his/her responsibilities may be removed from office by a 3/5 majority vote. A new officer will be determined by immediate election to fill the vacancy.

5.) The Executive Committee shall consist of all Executive Board Members and the club advisor, and shall meet periodically throughout the year.

6.) There shall be one club council representative. This individual shall attend all club meetings, as well as, all club council meetings, serving as a liaison between the two. The above clauses, #2, #3, and #4, will also hold true for this position.

7.) Special committees will be formed as needed, and the executive board members will be directly involved with those committees.

Article 4: Amendments

Amendments to this constitution may be changed by a 3/4 majority vote.
