The Senate received an update on the adaptation on the Diversity Plan from the Steering Committee for Inclusive Excellence and Provost Traverso, as well as priorities for the 2011-2012 academic year, including the launch Inclusive Excellence Website and communications plan for implementation activities, establish strategies and practices to recruit and retain a more diverse faculty and staff, establish a statement on community values and expectations and a statement about faculty rights and responsibilities, and offer staff and faculty development programs and training on Inclusive Excellence.
2. Five students have been selected to attend the Board of Trustees meeting to discuss off campus activities on Friday, April 29, 2011.
3. Senators taste tested new menu options crafted by Dining Services and voted on the top three recipes and the announcement of the winners will be done soon.
4. The Student Senate sponsored scholarships were open for nominations and the winners will be announced on Wednesday, April 27, 2011 at the Annual Student Awards Ceremony.
5. Student Athletes on the Lacrosse team approached the Senate about sponsoring a shuttle to the games, to which the Class of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, and the Executive Cabinet donated money for cause.
6. Betty Long and Tiffany Wells presented the design scheme for the Ober renovations and fielded questions and took suggestions.
